Re: San Diego Installation

The San Diego chapter of LAI held its annual Crystal Globe initiation banquet on February 1 at the elegant Westgate Hotel in downtown San Diego. More than 100 persons were in attendance to applaud the event.

The evening had three highlights:

The installation of 14 new members, representing a broad range of professions and experience in land economics. Installing officer Alan Nevin hosted the installation ceremony with fellow LAI members Suzanne Varco (LAI International Secretary) and Bill Kennedy, a long-time member of the chapter.

The second highlight was the Crystal Globe Award granted to Douglas Manchester, a local real estate developer who is largely responsible for the development of downtown San Diego's waterfront.
